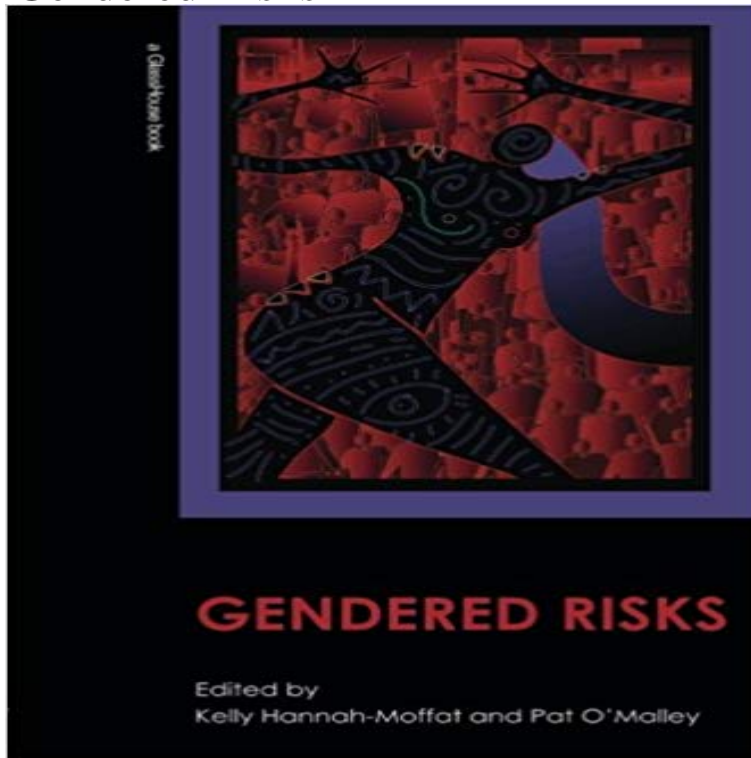


# Gendered Risks
