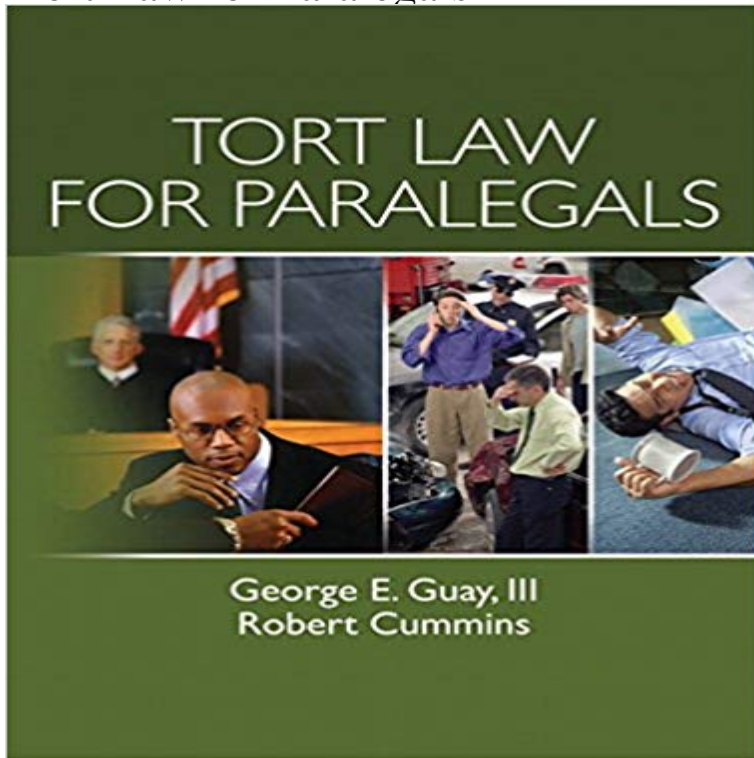


Tort Law for Paralegals
