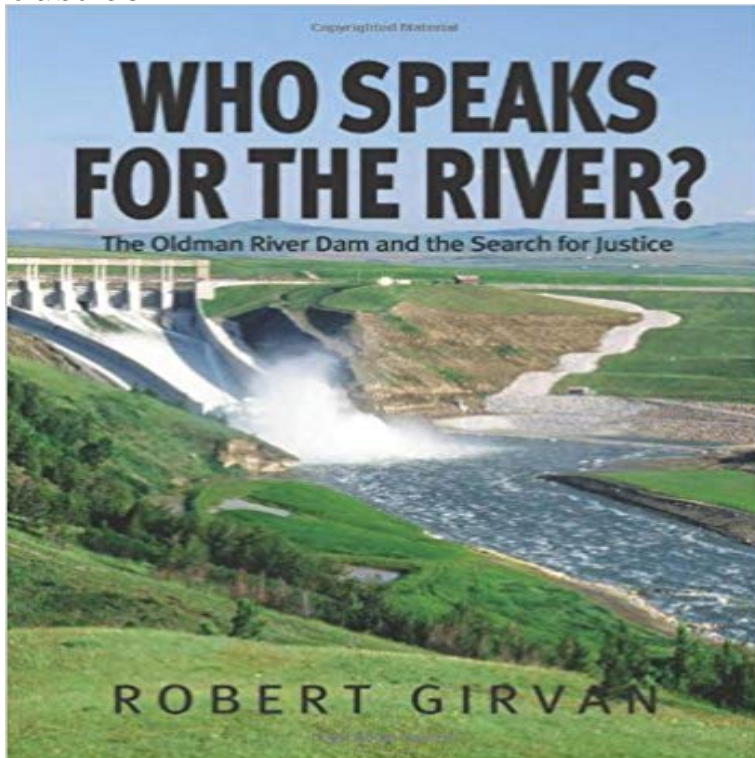


Who Speaks for the River?: The Oldman River Dam and the Search for Justice
